Completed Traffic Survival School Application A copy of a valid Fingerprint Clearance Card for each applicant, partner, sole proprietor, and all stockholders owning 20% or more of the entity. Information for the Fingerprint Clearance Card can be located at www.azdps.gov/services/fingerprint Completed Authorized Presence Documentation form Payment to ACNSC in an amount that includes \$200.00 for each school license requested and \$50 for each additional site/branch location once application is approved Corporation/LLC/LLP: Copy of Articles of Incorporation or Organization for name verification Corporation/LLC/LLP: Copy of Trade Name Certificate from Secretary of State for "dba" verification if "dba" not listed in Articles Photos of: ☐ Sign indicating hours of operation ☐ Entrance of office and classroom Front and back views of classroom Office area and secure records storage Sample copies of any and all contracts and forms of receipts to be used by the school Copies of all forms, pamphlets, and handouts used by the school which will be furnished or delivered to students A signed Lease from landowner granting permission for the site to be used as a Traffic Survival School, if the site is not owned by the school/if classroom, lease must include fire capacity. If the site is owned by the school, a deed of ownership must be submitted. Copies of any advertising for prior approval of both type and text One school principle and at least one instructor must have completed training and be certified to teach the



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### TRAFFIC SURVIVAL QUALIFIED INSTRUCTOR CHECKLIST



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 Completed "Traffic Survival School Instructor Application" for each school will teach with-
 Completed "Good Moral Character Statement".
 Completed MVD Form 96-0560 "Authorized Presence Documentation."
 Proof that instructor has completed the ACNSC "Attitudinal Dynamics of Driving" three-day workshop.
 Three (3) signed letters of reference.
 Statement from the manager of the sponsoring school certifying the applicant's ability to teach driving at a professional level.
 Proof of a minimum high school education or the equivalent.
 39 mo. Arizona MVR dated within 30 days of application. If the Arizona license-issue date is less than three years, the applicant must provide an MVR from their previous state licensed in; the applicant must provide as many MVRs as necessary to cover a minimum of three years of immediately past consecutive driving history.
 MVR can show no suspensions or revocations within the past 39 months.
 No convictions within the 5 years related to DUI, Reckless Driving, Aggressive Driving or Racing on a Highway.

Incomplete or insufficient applications will be denied.
